WHAT IS REDEDICATION?

Rededication is recommitting your life back to the Lord. The act of rededication is to denounce one's former way of living and commit to living fully for Christ. When someone rededicates, it is generally because they have separated or distanced themselves in their walk with the Lord or they are desiring to go deeper in their relationship with the Lord.

It is important to address that one cannot rededicate their life to the Lord if they first have not dedicated to the Lord. We receive salvation by believing in the birth, death, and resurrection of Jesus Christ and have accepted and confessed Jesus as our Lord and Savior. When one rededicates their life, they no longer walk in a way that satisfies their flesh but dedicates to follow Christ's standard of living by pursuing an intimate relationship with the Lord. According to **2 Corinthians 5:17** it says "Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come: The old has gone, the new is here!"

HOW DO I REDEDICATE MYSELF TO GOD?

1. Repent - Repentance means to turn. When we repent, we completely turn from our sins and turn to Christ's standard of living for our lives.

(Acts 3:19 "Repent, then, and turn to God, so that your sins may be wiped out, that times of refreshing may come from the Lord,")

- 2. Confess Confess that Jesus is Lord of your life
 - (<u>1 John 1:9</u> "If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.")
- 3. Believe Believe that He died on the Cross for your sins and resurrected from the dead (<u>John 6:40</u> "For this is the will of my Father, that everyone who looks on the Son and believes in him should have eternal life, and I will raise him up on the last day.")
