The Howard Family scholarships provide financial assistance for tuition, fees, housing, books, and other school related expenses for Black students pursuing higher education. The Howard family believes that post-secondary education has the potential to positively enhance life trajectories and create boundless career opportunities.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Applicants must identify as African American/Black
- Applicants must have a minimum GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale
- Applicants must plan to be enrolled full-time for fall 2024 at an accredited 2- or 4-year college, university, technical, or vocational school

Requirements:

- Applicants must submit a completed scholarship application.
- Applicants must respond to (3) of the following questions. The response for each question should not exceed 250 words.
 - What are your career and/or educational goals and aspirations?
 - How will receiving this scholarship assist you in pursuing your educational goals?
 - Describe your strengths as a student.
 - If someone were writing a book about you what would the title be and why?
- Upload a video that is 2 minutes or less that tells us why you should be a recipient of a Howard Family Foundation scholarship. Verify that your video is accessible prior to uploading.
- Applicants must submit a resume. Include your community service, extracurricular activities, work, volunteer experience, and any other community engagement.
- Applicants must have one letter of recommendation: Letter should be an academic or professional recommendation (e.g., teacher, professor, counselor, administrator, work/volunteer supervisor), letters from family and friends are not acceptable. The letter should be emailed by the recommender directly to The Howard Family Foundation by the scholarship application deadline.
- Applicants must submit a copy of their most recent transcript (official or unofficial).
- Applicants must submit a copy of their Student Aid Report (SAR) from FASFA or California Dream Act aid documents.
- All scholarship recipients will be required to demonstrate proof of enrollment
